_____ **Area 2:** Sit along our “roped off” area, to protect the students & instruments from spectators, put bleacher covers in place and roll them up after the game, additional bathroom monitors when needed.

_____ **Area 3:** Welcoming other bands to our stadium (*during home games only*), set up water coolers for visiting bands, be there when they arrive to clap & cheer when they enter the stadium and assist in getting them into the stands, check with them after half time to see if they need anymore water.
